On the edge of the Bannau Brycheiniog National Park, our tented village offers a world of different experiences – talks, music, comedy, great food and drink, and the unexpected.

Launching the best new books, while offering insights and debate around significant global issues, our programme features award-winning writers, policy makers, pioneers and innovators from around the world.

And at night, the world's greatest performers take to the stage to offer a heady dose of entertainment and joy.

## Why join us?

#### Feed our audience.

People from around the world travel to Hay Festival with more than 150,000 people visiting our free to enter Festival site.

### Showcase your creations.

Food traders are a vital part of the Festival experience, providing our audiences an opportunity to try your delicious creations.

Be part of a quality experience. Each year 12 of the very best festival food traders, tempt taste buds, and provide vegan, veggie and gluten free options ensuring there is something for everyone.

#### You're in safe hands.

Food traders are collectively located in our undercover Canteen. Long dining tables are regularly cleaned and rubbish is removed by our recycling team. You will be provided with a dedicated support team on hand to help you from install to derig.



### Rate card

We ask for 20% commission from all food traders, calculated on net turnover, with a non-refundable minimum guarantee. This minimum guarantee is payable prior to the Festival and deducted from the total commission due at the end of the Festival.

The Canteen is our main covered dining area, but there are other limited opportunities in our family area, an outdoor space that typically closes earlier in the evening.

Power and additional plumbing is charged separately and items not provided that you will need to bring:

- Front of house marquee or unit structure
- Back of house equipment and structures,
- e.g. fridge unit, van storage facilities, etc.Decoration and signage, including detailed menu boards and allergy signage
